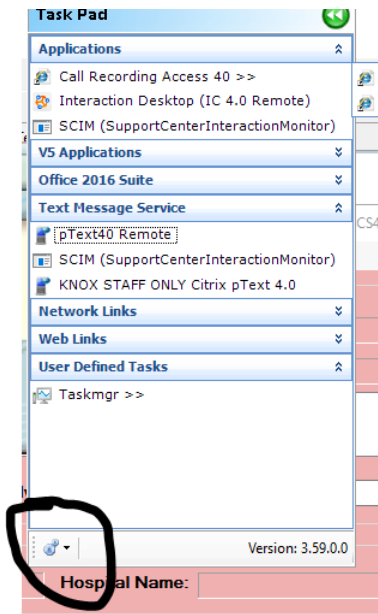
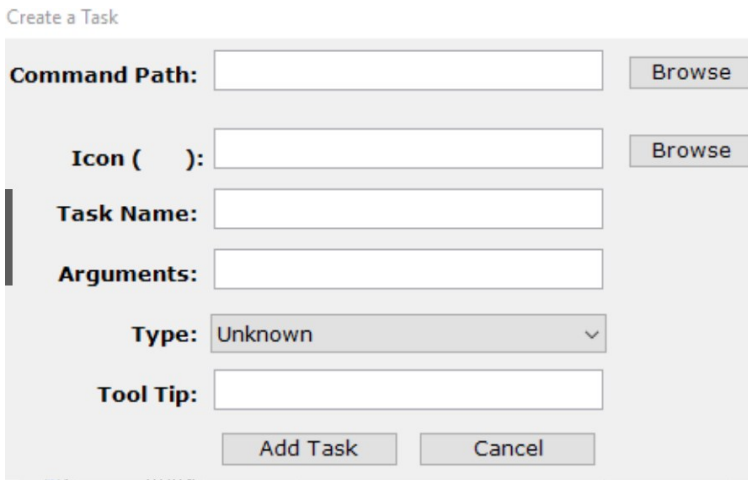


These are the steps to follow in order for us to be able to successfully download the task manager into the task pad:



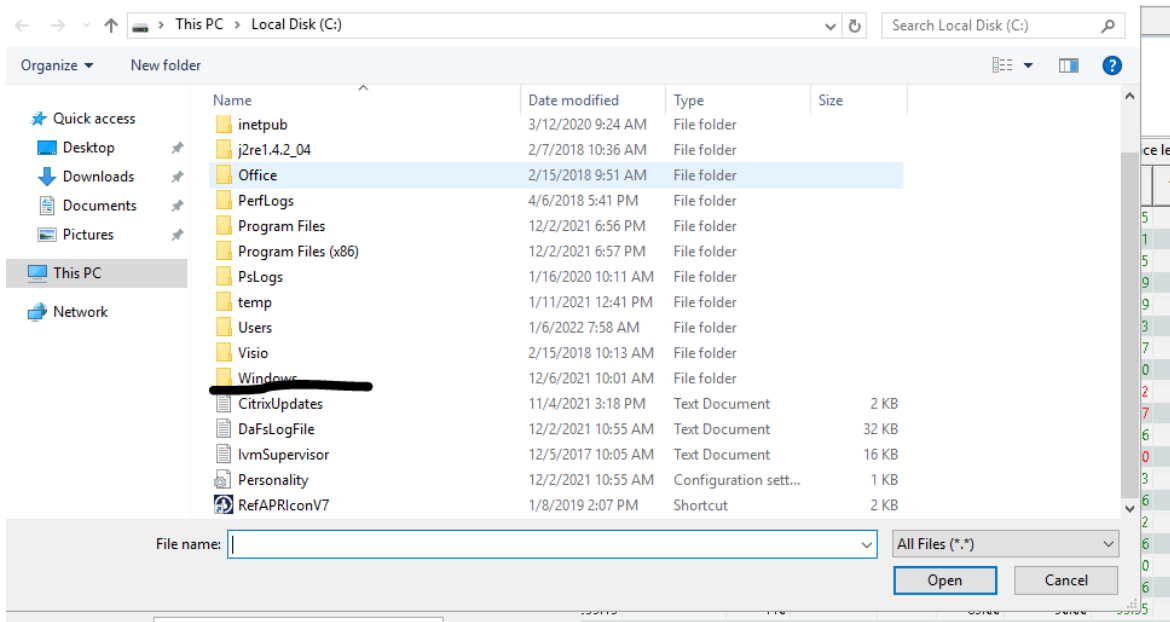
First, you have to drop down the arrow there and select "add new task"

it will open up the next window:

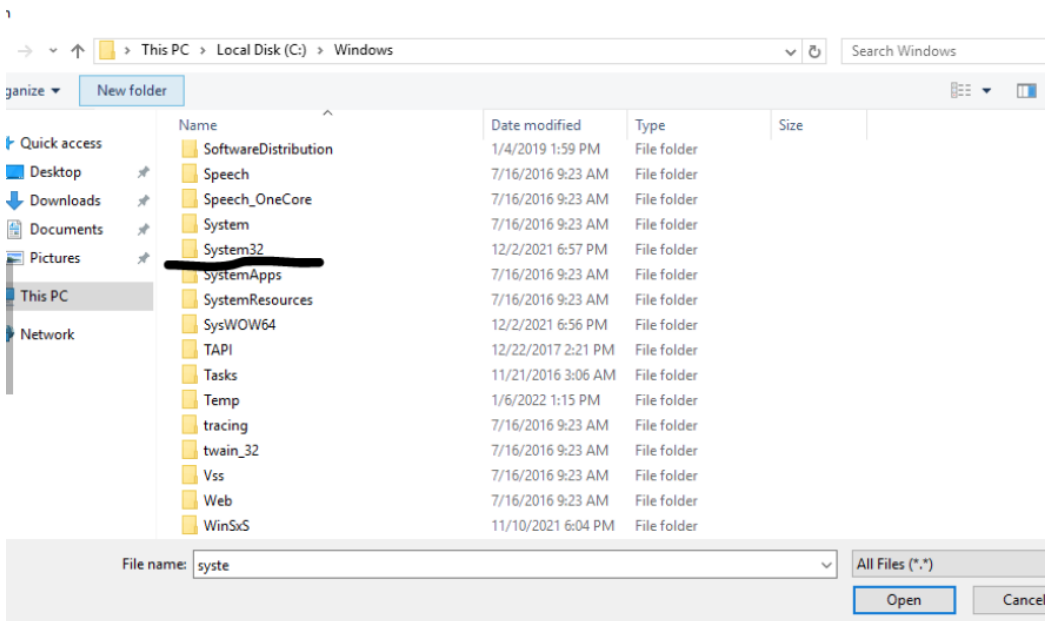


then you will proceed to hit browse, this will open up a window that contains various folders and files:

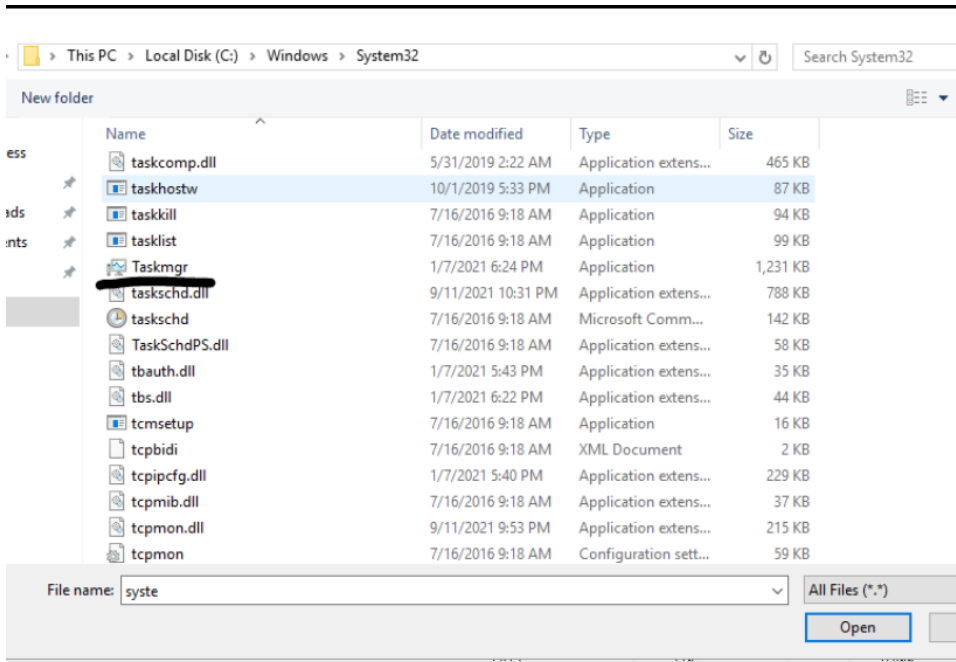
you will be searching for the folder that says WINDOWS:



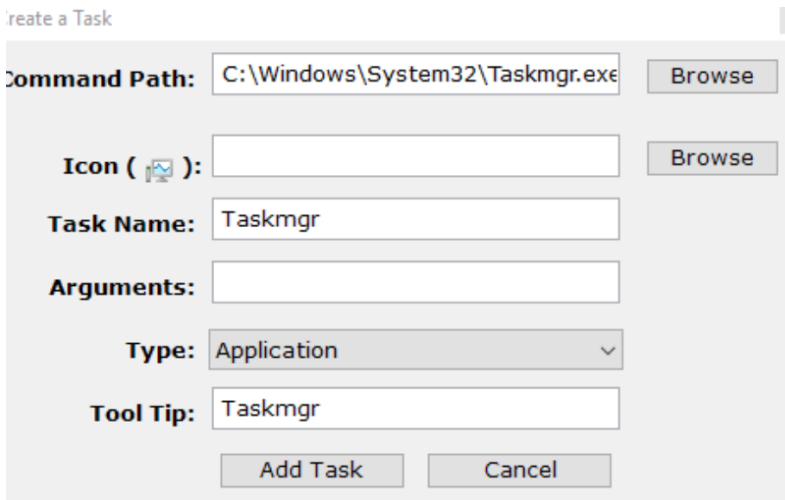
Double click on it, and it will show you another set of files, and you will now be searching for a folder named system32. You will drop down until you alphabetically get to it.



You will again double click on this folder, and will now be searching for TASKMGR:



Once you have located this file, you will select it and hit open, which will take you back to the first screen with the task manager included:



At this point, you only need to hit "add task" and it will automatically open the task manager and it will now be available for you to use it.

Be aware that this feature may get erased from time to time, so if it happens you will need to follow these steps all over again in order to regain access.
